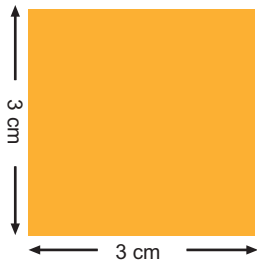


Importante! To use this page, you must follow the next steps.

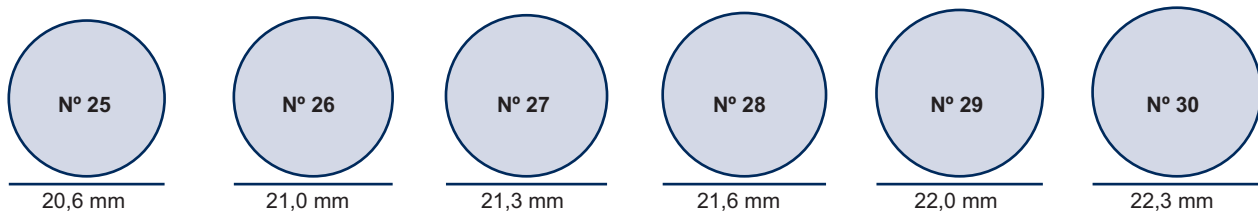
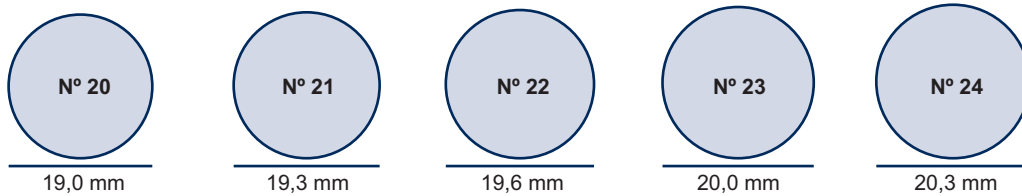
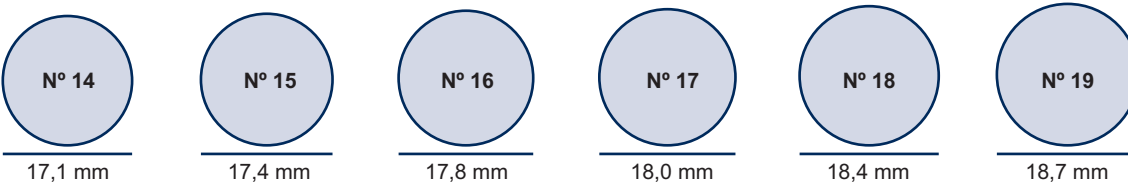
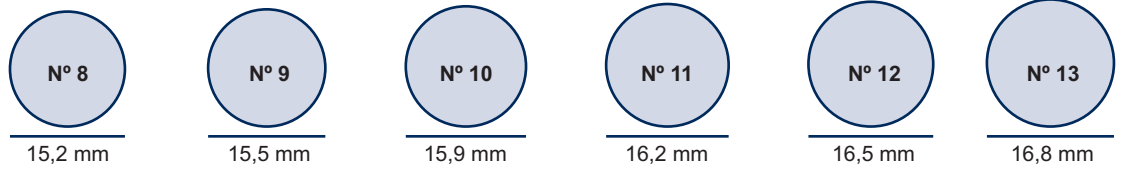


- Before printing, go to Archive menu, print, page scale, None, ACCEPT
- After printing, measure with a ruler the orange square to the left of this page, that it's size is exactly 3cm by 3cm
- If the orange square does NOT measure 3 x 3cm, the measure will not work. Go back to printing the page and ensure the page scaling says NONE
- Print the page and you can choose between the two methods. Method A is the easiest and most exact.

Method A

Using one of your own rings, place it on top of one of the circles below, until the ring fits perfectly inside the circle, See examples to the right (No 8, 9, 10)

As well as the ring size, we have also included the diameter size of the ring. The space to measure is exactly the space of the inside of the ring where it must not touch the outer ring. See diagram to the right (No 8, 9, 10)



Method B

Cut the following measure around the outline and cut the dotted line where it says 'cut here'

Adjust the ring measure to the desired size by pulling firmly until it fits comfortably. Make a note of the size on the ring measure.
